Some would even argue saying, "it doesn't matter what the name is", and some would say that I just believe in the son of God. Others also say, "When I read my book it says Jesus!" That therefore is a true statement, because when we read the bible it do say Jesus in the writings. However let us examine through comparing and contrasting to see if the

names fit the one doctrine that is written in this one story. After comparing and contrasting, you judge for yourself to see if Yahshua and Jesus are the same; the son of the True and Living God, Yahweh. Consider this. McDonald's has a specific recipe that gives it a specific taste no matter where you go in the world. And when you taste it, the flavor lets us know that this is a McDonald's burger because the recipe stays constant. Therefore if Yahshua and Jesus are the same, wherever you go the doctrine should also be constant. Let's examine.

What Language did Christ Speak?

Christ Spoke the Hebrew Language

"And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue (language), Saul, Saul, why persecutest you me? It is hard for you to kick against the pricks. And I said, Who are you, Adonai (Lord)? And he said, I am Yahshua whom you persecutest." - Acts 26:14-15.

And they said unto him, In Bethlehem of Judaea: for thus it is written by the prophet, And you Bethlehem, in the land of Juda, are not the least among the princes of Judah: for out of you shall come a Governor, that shall rule my people Israel." What did Yahshua the Christ preach?

When did Christ go to the synagogue?

"And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read." Luke 4:16

Why did Christ keep the Sabbath on the 7th day of the week?

And on the seventh day God (Elohim) ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. And God (Elohim) blessed the seventh day, and sanctified: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God (Elohim) created and made. Gen. 2:2-3 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the sabbath of Yahweh (the LORD) thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days Yahweh (the LORD) made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Yahweh (LORD) blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it. Exod. 20:9-11

Who changed the Sabbath from the 7th day unto the 1st day of the week (Sunday)?
